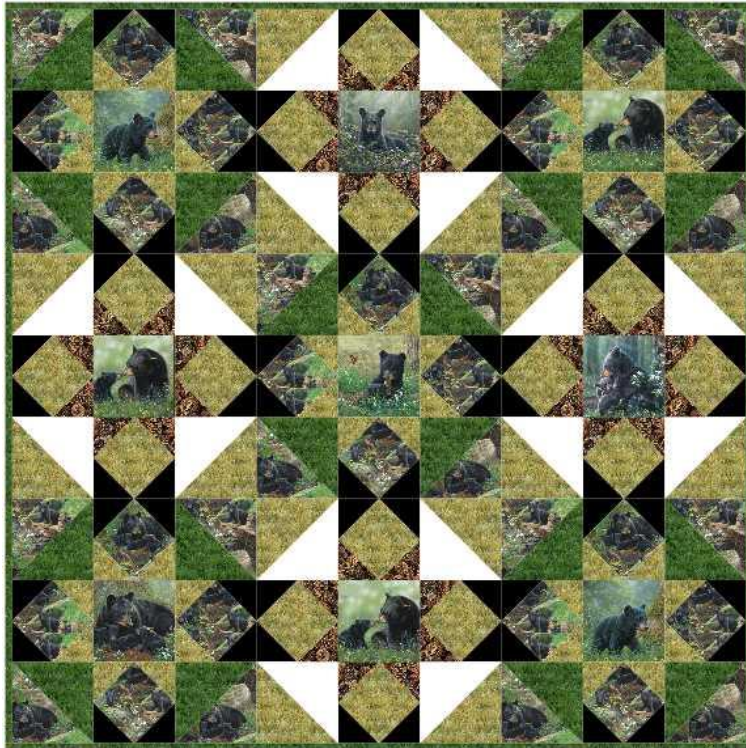


# TENDER MOMENTS

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**FABRIC: Tender Moments by Abraham Hunter for Elizabeth's Studio LLC**

**9606 Black (block panel)**—2/3 yard

**9608 Green (scenic)**—1-1/2 yards

**250 Light Green (allover)**—1-1/2 yards

**250 Green (allover)**—1/2 yard

**454 Brown (allover)**—1/3 yard

**Black Solid**—3/4 yard

**White Solid**—1/2 yard

**250 Green (allover)**—1/2 yard for binding

Backing for 54" square quilt top—3-3/4 yards

### **Cutting Directions:**

**9606 Black (block panel):** Fussy cut (9) 6-1/2" squares, centering motifs.

**9608 Green (scenic):** Cut (2) 6-7/8" x WOF (width of fabric), cross cut into (10) 6-7/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally, cutting half in each direction. ☐ ☐

Cut (4) 6-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strip, cross cut into (20) 6-1/2" squares. Extra fabric is allowed to center motifs.

**250 Light Green (allover):** Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (40) 3-1/2" squares.

Cut (2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (8) 6-7/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally, cutting four in each direction. ☐ ☐

Cut (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (16) 6-1/2" squares.

**250 Green (allover):** Cut (2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (10) 6-7/8" squares, then cut once on the diagonal to form (20) half-square triangles—cut (5) squares in each direction. ☐ ☐

**454 Brown (allover):** Cut (2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (32) 3-1/2" squares.

**White Solid:** Cut (2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (8) 6-7/8" squares, then cut once on the diagonal to form (16) half-square triangles. ☐

**Black Solid:** Cut (7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (72) 3-1/2" squares.

**250 Green (allover):** Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF binding strips, set aside.

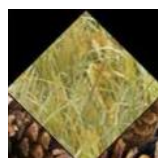
## **CONSTRUCTING BLOCKS:**

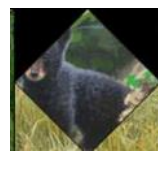
### **HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE UNITS:**

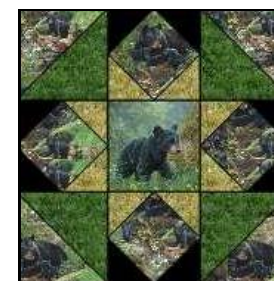
Sew together (20) 6-7/8" **9608 Green (scenic)** and (20) 6-7/8" **250 Green (allover)** half-square triangles to form (20) corner units. *Take care to orient all directional fabrics correctly—each corner is different. Refer to diagrams at right as needed.* Repeat using (16) 6-7/8" **White Solid (allover)** and (16) 6-7/8" **250 Light Green (allover)** half-square triangles to form (16) corner units.

*Note on using directional fabrics: It may be helpful to lay out, then sew the units for one block at a time, i.e. make all four half-square triangle units for one block. As you can see from the diagrams, the fabrics are oriented in four different ways for each block. Otherwise, you may end up with grass growing sideways!*

### **DIAMOND IN SQUARE UNITS:**

 Using the “stitch and flip” method, sew together (2) 3-1/2" **454 Brown (allover)** squares, (2) 3-1/2" **Black Solid** squares and (1) 6-1/2" **250 Light Green (allover)** square to form unit. Repeat to create (16) units. *Again refer to the diagram to create four different units for each block.*

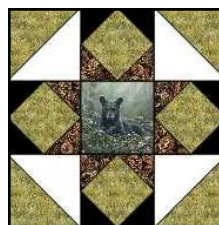
 Sew together (2) 3-1/2" **250 Light Green (allover)** squares, (2) 3-1/2" **Solid Black** squares and (1) 6-1/2" **9608 Green (scenic)** squares to form unit. Repeat to complete (20) units. *Again be sure to orient the fabrics correctly, especially when stitching and flipping the 250 Light Green (allover) squares.*



### **COMPLETING THE BLOCKS:**

Referring to diagram for color placement, combine (4) half-square triangle units, (4) diamond in square units and (1) 6-1/2" fussy cut **9606 Black (block panel)** square to form block.

Make (4) blocks



Make (5) blocks



### **COMPLETING THE CENTER SECTION:**

Sew the nine blocks together to form the center section, alternating colors.

### **COMPLETING THE QUILT:**

Layer with batting and backing. Use the reserved **250 Green (allover)** binding strips to complete the quilt.
